INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all instructions before completing your application to Virginia Wesleyan College.

It is to your advantage to send the application and all pertinent credentials for admission to the Dean of Admissions as early as possible. The Admissions Committee will consider your application as soon as it is complete, and your admissions counselor will keep you informed about the status of your file. Please pay careful attention to the following matters:

I. Application. This form should be filed out accurately, legibly and completely. Failure to complete all sections of the application may result in a processing delay. If a question is not pertinent to you, put a dash or NA in the space provided.

II. Application Fee. A non-refundable fee of \$40 must accompany the application form. Checks or money orders should be made payable to Virginia Wesleyan College.

III. Social Security Number. If you do not have a social security number, you should obtain one from your local Social Security Office as soon as possible. International students will be assigned an identification number by the College.

IV. Credentials Required For High School Students.

1. Application form completed, signed and accompanied by the application fee
2. Official transcript from each high school attended, sent directly to the College from the high school
3. Official copy of SAT or ACT scores if not provided on the high school transcript
4. Guidance counselor recommendation

V. Credentials Required For Transfer Students.

1. Application form completed, signed and accompanied by the application fee
2. Official transcripts for each college or university attended, sent directly from the institution to VWC
3. Official copies of SAT or ACT scores if fewer than 12 credit hours have been earned
4. Official copies of high school transcripts if fewer than 12 credit hours have been earned
5. While we do not require high school transcripts if you have earned at least 12 credit hours of college work, we recommend that you have one sent to us. We can use it for proper placement in foreign language courses, perhaps exempting you from some required courses. For this reason, it is to your advantage to submit a high school transcript.

VI. Credentials Required for International Students.

International Students are required to submit a separate application for admission. The International Student Application may be obtained from the admissions office or from our website, www.vwc.edu.

VII. College Entrance Tests. For entering freshman, Virginia Wesleyan requires either SAT I or ACT scores. Although we do not require more than one SAT or ACT score, we do take the highest individual Verbal and Math scores from the tests taken.

Our CEEB code is 5867. Transfer students with more than 12 credit hours, veterans and students over 23 years of age are exempt from the SAT/ACT requirement.

VIII. General Admission Guidelines. Every application at Virginia Wesleyan is reviewed individually by the Admissions Committee. If you have specific questions about your individual admission criteria, please contact one of our admissions counselors regarding your potential for admission. Students are required to live in campus residence halls unless they meet the qualifications for commuting indicated in our residence policy.

XI. Applicants For Adult Studies Program. Students planning to attend class evenings and weekends only should not complete this application. The appropriate application can be requested by calling (757) 455-3263.
