Supporting Current Virginia Wesleyan Students

Virginia Wesleyan College will award funds to current students based on academic performance and extracurricular involvement. The selection process and number of scholarships will depend on the number of applications received. Awards will range from \$1,000 to \$5,000. Awards from the Marlin Scholarship Fund will not be automatically renewed. Students must reapply annually.

APPLICATION

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Applicants must
- Be a current full-time, degree-seeking, day student enrolled at Virginia Wesleyan for the spring 2009 semester.
 - Have completed a minimum of 24 credit hours by the end of the spring 2009 semester.
 - Have at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA at Virginia Wesleyan at the end of the fall 2008 semester.

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Students must enroll full time for the 2009-2010 academic year and maintain satisfactory academic progress.

The application and all requested materials must be received in the Financial Aid Office by **April 1, 2009**.

All awards will be issued by May 1, 2009 for the 2009-2010 academic year, to be evenly distributed between the fall and spring semesters.
