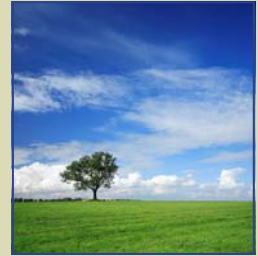

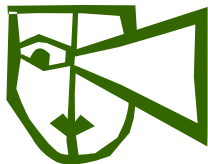
If you desire transportation, you must reserve your seat by **Thursday, October 23** in the Career Services Center. **Cost is \$10.**
