Deadline for all scholarship applications: **OCTOBER 31, 2008**

1. currently attend a VFIC College or University,
2. be a full-time undergraduate student,
3. be a citizen of the United States,
4. submit a resume with your application and have two letters of recommendation mailed to the VFIC no later than October 31, 2008
5. meet ALL criteria, etc. for the scholarship for which you are applying (see below).

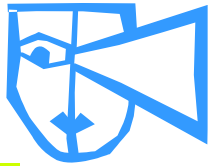
